Discussion continued of the draft material Sven has prepared. There is an undescribed model behind the IR procedures which would be helpful to understand when which procedures. Sven will attempt to have something for discussion in 4 weeks. The sharing procedures are focused on the role of an operator of a federated entity, and the AARC paper breaks procedures out for each of various roles. Need to align.
