## Requirements for survey tool

- Does survey tool have to be free / do we have a budget?
- Must allow multiple administrators
- Anonymous survey or do we want to be the Data Controller (in the GDPR sense)?
- What size of survey response are we expecting? The current list of communities includes many thousands of people
- We talked about distinct questions for different communities. Does that mean we want separate surveys, or a single survey with some logic to say who gets which questions?
- The draft questions we have for IdP operators and SP operators are probing for specific information (radio buttons, small text boxes) whereas those for end users, organizations and risks are much more qualitative.
- What kind of output / analysis will be made on the data?
