## **Entity Category Consultation: Research and Scholarship**

In July 2014, it was noted that there was an error in the R&S Entity Category definition and REFEDS participants agreed to make changes to fix this error and were invited to propose other minor updates. As there is live usage of the R&S Entity Category it was agreed that changes in this review should be kept as minimal as possible so as not to create major changes to the meaning of existing implementations. This should be used as the driving decision point for the review.

10	Internet2 proposal for a section on 'normative statements':	This section is only required if the the REFEDS proposal seeks to control the behaviour of ALL R&S like entity categories AND propose its own implementation of it. I would suggest that we ONLY want to seek to control the REFEDS R&S Entity Category, so this section is not needed. For discussion.
