	HOW TO WITHDRAW
<b>Austria ACONet</b>	(6.2A)The ACONet Identity Federation member MAY cancel an ACONet Identity Federation membership at any time by sending a written request to the ACONet Identity Federation Operations Team. A cancellation of the ACONet Identity Federation membership implies the automatic and immediate cancellation of the use of all Technology Profiles for the organization.
<b>Australia AAF</b>	13.1 A Subscriber may voluntarily withdraw from the Australian Access Federation upon 20 Working Days' notice to AAF Inc.Following cessation of the Subscriber's participation (under any circumstances): 14.1 AAF Inc. will cease to publish the Subscriber's Metadata and will inform the remaining Subscribers that the Subscriber is no longer a Subscriber; 14.2 the Subscriber will, at its own cost: 14.2.1 cease to hold itself out as being a Subscriber and, if it is an Identity Provider will inform its End Users that its subscription has ceased; and 14.2.2 remove the Federation logo from all of its materials.
<b>Canada CAF</b>	NONE
<b>Czech Republic eduID</b>	6.1 Should a member organization decide to leave the federation on its own volition, the intention needs to be communicated to the Federation Operator in writing, at least one month in advance. The Federation Operator will make preparations for technical disconnection of the member within the time frame and publish the information at the <a href="http://www.eduID.cz">www.eduID.cz</a> information portal. 8.3 All modifications to this Policy need to be announced three months in advance and discussed with all federation members as possible. In case of a new rule being deemed unacceptable by a member, that member is obliged to leave the federation by the date the new rule becomes effective (following Section 6 of this Document). Parties that fail to do so agree with the new wording of the Federation Policy without reservation.
<b>Denmark WAYF</b>	14 Notice and termination Either party may terminate the contract by serving one month's written notice of the end of a month. This deadline does not apply in the event of breach of contract, cf. clause 8.
<b>Spain - SIR</b>	NONE
<b>Finland - HAKA</b>	10. Validity period, amendment and termination of the Agreement The Agreement shall be valid until further notice. The notice period for termination of the Agreement shall be six months. The Operator shall be entitled to change the Appendices to this Agreement upon hearing to the Federation's Advisory Group. The amendment shall be notified to the Federation Partners in writing at least three (3) months prior to the effective date of the amendment. The notification shall be delivered to the administrative contact person designated by the Federation Partner, as set forth in section 9. In addition, the amendment shall be informed on the Operator's website accessible to the Federation Partners. The information shall then contain not only a description of the amendment but also the new, amended Appendix to the Agreement in full. The amended Appendix shall, when enforced, replace the corresponding earlier Appendix. The Federation Partner shall be entitled to terminate the Agreement by submitting a written notice to the Operator, as set forth in section 9, within thirty (30) days from the date of receiving the Operator's notification on the amendment of the Appendix. The termination shall then be valid on the effective date of the Appendix to the Agreement, informed by the Operator in advance. Notwithstanding the above, amendments to the software licenses (Appendix 5) needed for the use of the AAI services shall become effective as stipulated in the respective amendments. Additionally, the Federation's Advisory Committee shall be entitled to decide on urgent amendments that are imperative for the operational integrity of the Federation concerning Appendix 3 of the Agreement. Such amendments to Appendix 3 shall become effective after the Operator has confirmed the amendment and informed the Federation Partners of the changes and the effective date of the amendment. A party shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement immediately, if the other party commits an essential breach to a provision of this Agreement and does not cure the breach within a reasonable time (a minimum of 30 days) from having received a written notification about the breach. The Federation Partner shall also be entitled to terminate the Agreement immediately, if the use of the services is essentially interrupted and 60 days have passed since a notification has been given to the Operator and the Operator has been unable to execute corrective actions regarding the service.
<b>France - Federation Recherche</b>	Subscription to the Federation is for an unlimited period, but the Partner is free to unsubscribe at any time with a prior one (1) month notice period to the GIP RENATER.
<b>Ireland - edugate</b>	3.5 The Provider Member's membership of the Edugate Federation is provided on an annual basis and will be automatically renewed each year on the anniversary date of this Agreement unless the Provider Member gives thirty (30) days notice in writing to the Administrator of the Provider Member's intention to cease its Membership of the Edugate Federation or in the event that this Agreement is terminated for any reason set out herein.
<b>Japan - Gakunin</b>	NONE

<b>Portugal- RCTSAAI</b>	NONE
<b>Sweden SWAMID</b>	(6.2)A SWAMID membership MAY be cancelled by the SWAMID Member at any time by sending a request to the SWAMID Operations Team. A cancellation of the SWAMID membership implies the automatic and immediate cancellation of the use of all SWAMID Technology Profiles for the organisation.
<b>UK UK federation</b>	9.1. The Member may voluntarily withdraw from the Federation upon 20 Working Days' notice to the Federation Operator. 10. Following cessation of the Member's membership (under any circumstances): 10.1. the Federation Operator will cease to publish the Member's Metadata and will inform the remaining Members that the organisation is no longer a Member; 10.2. the organisation, institution or individual (as the case may be) will, at its own cost: 10.2.1. cease to hold itself out as being a Member and will inform its End Users that its membership has ceased; 10.2.2. remove the Federation logo from all of its materials.
<b>US - InCommon</b>	5b. Participant Withdrawal from InCommon Federation. Participant shall be permitted to withdraw from participation in the Federation at any time by giving written notice to InCommon of its intent to terminate its participation. If Participant withdraws from the Federation under this Section 5b, Participant shall not be entitled to a refund of its Registration or Annual Participation Fees.
